I have been engaged in the Rural-Urban Migration in China and Indonesia (RUMICI) Study. This project aims at investigating the welfare and labour market activities of individuals who move from rural to urban areas as well as the well-being of their family members, in the two large developing countries with different socio-economic and political contexts. For this purpose, the Study is conducting the five-year panel survey of rural-urban migrants in the two countries
